San Francisco Area Narcotics Anonymous Meeting Schedule

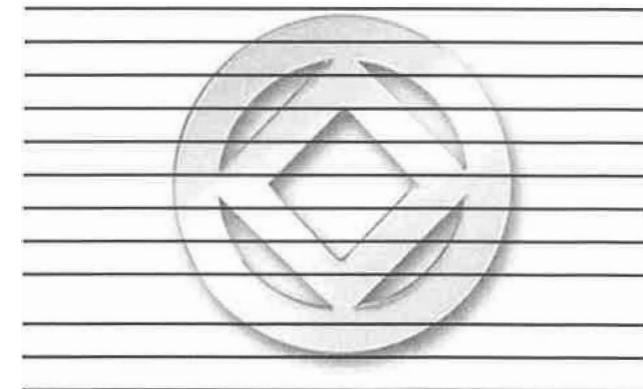
